INSTRUCTIONS: You may use this form to apply for most undergraduate merit awards offered by the Institute of Technology. Complete the form and requirements below in duplicate (**two copies**, each individually stapled and copies paper-clipped together). Submit application to 128 Lind Hall by February 27, 2009, along with:

- a University of Minnesota transcript (unofficial transcripts are acceptable; an APAS report is not acceptable). You must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 at the University of Minnesota to be considered for a scholarship.
- a 300-word (maximum) essay (typed, double spaced) describing your vocational aspirations after graduation, and most interesting experience as an IT student. If financial need is an issue, please include information regarding need.
- a resume which includes leadership positions you have held, work experience, research experience, and extracurricular activities.

NOTE: If you receive a scholarship, you must register for a minimum of 13 credits per semester. You cannot receive scholarship money for a term in which you are doing a co-op. You will receive notification regarding the scholarship via mail by June 1, 2009.
